PROFESSIONAL PARENT/ FOSTER PARENT PROGRAM

As a licensed provider of children's services in the state of Utah, Phoenix adheres to the belief that children (regardless of their disability) become contributing members of society when they are provided with a safe, nurturing, and supportive home environment.

In addition to services previously listed, Phoenix also provides assistance in the area of foster placement. Those who meet the criteria for becoming a foster parent through Phoenix are referred to as 'Professional Parents.' Below is an overview of the Professional Parent/Foster Parent Program:

- ✓ Those interested in becoming a Professional Parent are required to attend a pre-service training offered by the Utah Foster Care Foundation.
- ✓ Professional Parents are also required to attend an orientation sponsored by Phoenix and participate in ongoing educational opportunities.
- ✓ Professional Parents must consent to a home study and thorough background checks.
- ✓ Phoenix staff members make every effort to ensure that a child is matched with a parent well suited to meet the child's needs.

- ✓ Professional parents will maintain required documentation, such as incident reports, medical forms and other pertinent information.
- ✓ Although Phoenix supports permanent placement for all children receiving our services, Phoenix will not be involved in the adoption process—the Professional Parent Program involves foster placement only. Those interested in the adoption process will be referred to appropriate state agencies.
- ✓ Phoenix Services Corporation does not deny any person the opportunity to become a foster parent on the basis of race, color, or national origin.
- ✓ Phoenix Services Corporation does not delay or deny the placement of a child into foster care on the basis of race, color, or national origin.

In addition to concern for the well being of the children we serve, Phoenix also offers a high standard of support to birth parents, professional parents and others who may be involved in the care and placement of a child. All efforts are made to develop, implement and maintain a positive and cohesive team that will optimally benefit the child.
